REGISTER FOR CODERED ALERTS!

CODERED ALERTS is a citizen notification system to receive alerts and updates during emergency and special events affecting the Town of Mars Hill. The Town will use **CODERED** to relay information such as emergency conditions, road detours, water line breaks, weather-related directives, closures, or other service-related and event information through phone calls, text messages, emails, and social media.

Participation in this alert notification system is voluntary and registration must be initiated by the citizen or business owner. Registration can be completed online at the website: <u>https://accountportal.onsolve.net/marshillalerts</u> OR from your smartphone by texting **ALERTMARSHILL** to 24639. If you do not have internet access, please visit Town Hall at 280 North Main Street, or call (828) 689-2301 for assistance by town staff to complete the registration.
