RE: New Recycling Plan

The Town has contracted with a company that will take our recycled goods in a mixed fashion. It will no longer be necessary to separate the items for disposal. The following is a guide for disposal:

WHAT MAY I RECYCLE?

- Metal Cans & Empty Aerosol Cans – Aluminum, Steel, Tin
- Plastics: Only food, beverage, personal care and household plastic containers.
Exception: NO black microwavable trays and NO Styrofoam!
(EMPTY all bottles, cans, and containers – lids and labels may remain on.)
- Glass Bottles & Jars – Clear, Brown, Green
- Aluminum Pie Tins and Food Trays
- Milk & Juice Cartons (EMPTY)
- Corrugated Cardboard
(BREAK DOWN and FLATTEN)
- Newspapers & Inserts
- Mixed Paper
Catalogs, Junk mail, Magazines, Paper egg cartons, Envelopes, Office paper, Phone books, Glossy paper, Cereal boxes, Brown paper bags, Paper towel rolls, shredded paper (to be placed in a paper bag with top rolled down), etc.

BE SURE TO SECURE LID ON CONTAINERS TO PREVENT PAPER FROM BLOWING OUT!

WHAT IS NOT RECYCLABLE

- NO Styrofoam
- NO Dishes or Cookware
- NO Aluminum Foil
- NO Plastic Wrap
- NO Window or Mirror Glass
- NO Batteries
- NO Plastic Bags
- NO Drinking Glasses
- NO Light Bulbs
- NO Paper Towels, Napkins or Tissue
- NO Black Microwavable Trays
- NO Rigid or Bulky Plastics
