The meeting was called to order by Mayor Chandler with the first item of business being approval of the October, 2016, Minutes. The Minutes were approved unanimously on a motion by Bob Zink and second from Stuart Jolley.

Being no Agenda Modifications, a motion was made by Bob Zink to approve the Agenda as presented. Larry Davis gave a second and it was unanimously approved.

There was discussion about possible building of Tiny Homes within the Town. As long as the homes meet zoning regulations and building code, there should be no issues.

There was discussion about October Road operating and administering drugs at the Crossroads Parkway Complex. Darhyl will have Police Chief check to insure they are licensed through the State.

The Mayor and Aldermen discussed any possible legal actions that might be taken concerning vacant down-town buildings. Larry Leake expressed that there were no legal actions that could force a property owner into action.


