# MINUTES REGULAR MEETING Mars Hill Town Hall – Conference Room April 1, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.

The Town of Mars Hill Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session on Monday, April 1, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Mars Hill Town Hall.

### Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Chandler. Mayor Chandler welcomed those in attendance.

### Approval of the Agenda

Mayor Chandler asked the Board to review the proposed agenda for approval. Upon review of the agenda and hearing no changes or additions to be made, Mayor Chandler called for a motion. Alderman Nicholas Honeycutt made a motion that the agenda be approved as presented. Alderman

Stuart Jolley seconded the motion. Upon a call for a vote on the motion by the Mayor, the agenda was approved unanimously. (Attachment A)

### **Approval of Minutes**

The minutes of the regular meeting occurring on March 4, 2019 were presented. There being no modifications to the minutes, Alderman Jolley made a motion that the minutes be approved as presented by management, Alderman Honeycutt seconded the motion. Upon a call for a vote on the motion by the Mayor, the minutes were approved unanimously.

### Mars Hill Smith Farm Park Project and PARTF Application

### Nathan R. Bennett, Town Manager

Mayor Chandler then recognized Town Manager Nathan Bennett to provide information regarding the Mars Hill Smith Farm Park Project and the grant application proposal to the N.C. Parks and Recreation Trust Fund (PARTF) for project development funding. This meeting immediately followed the public meeting whereby a thorough presentation on these subjects were made and discussion, input and public comment was received from the general public on this project. Mr. Bennett summarized activities by Town staff and that he has worked very closely with the Land of Sky Regional Council in developing a project supported by planning and public engagement. Mr. Bennett provided a summary of all four resolutions appearing on the agenda and the purpose and need for these resolutions regarding the grant application to the N.C. Parks and Recreation Trust Fund. Upon discussion of the resolutions by the Board and staff, Mayor Chandler called for a motion. Alderman Robert Zink made a motion to approve the following resolutions as presented by management:

- 1. RESOLUTION Town of Mars Hill Parks and Recreation Comprehensive Systemwide Masterplan (Attachment B)
- 2. RESOLUTION Town of Mars Hill Parks and Recreation Capital Improvement Plan (Attachment C)
- 3. RESOLUTION Mars Hill Smith Farm Park Masterplan (Attachment D)
- 4. RESOLUTION Authorizing Grant Application to the N.C. Parks and Recreation Trust Fund (Attachment E)

Alderman Jolley seconded the motion. Upon a call for a vote on the motion by the Mayor, the motion was approved unanimously.

### Petition for Annexation - Lunsford Property - Pine Ridge Road

Mayor Chandler then recognized Mr. Bennett for a report on the investigation into the request for non-contiguous annexation. Mr. Bennett presented a report on the petition for the non-contiguous annexation request by Bruce and Doris Lunsford for their property located on Pine Ridge Road. Mr. Bennett advised that he has consulted with each Town department and this location is serviceable by

all town services except that sewer service is not available in the area. Any annexation approved should stipulate that the Town will not provide sewer or other utility service not currently provided to this location.

Alderman Zink stated that this is a request for voluntary annexation from the property owner. He stressed that it be made abundantly clear that sewer service is not available to this property and made in the record of these minutes.

Mayor Chandler open the public hearing portion of the meeting to hear any comments from the public concerning this pending requested for voluntary non-contiguous annexation. There being no public comments on the subject, Mayor Chandler closed the public hearing.

Mr. Bennett advised the Board that he recommends approval of the non-contiguous annexation petition request with the stipulation that the present property owner and any future property owners acknowledge that public sewer service is not available to this property and the Town of Mars Hill will not be responsible for the extension of said sewer service.

Upon completion of discussion of this request, Mayor Chandler called for a motion. Alderman Jolley made a motion to approve the non-contiguous annexation request of the Bruce and Doris Lunsford property located on Pine Ridge Road (and more fully described in Attachment "F" to the minutes) with the stipulation that the Town of Mars Hill will not be responsible to provide public utilities (e.g. sewer service) not already currently available to the property as of this date. Alderman Honeycutt seconded the motion. Upon a call for a vote on the motion by the Mayor, the motion was approved unanimously.

### Town Manager Report - Nathan Bennett, Town Manager

Mayor Chandler then recognized Mr. Bennett to provide the Town Manager Report.

Land of Sky Regional Council of Government Board of Delegates Alternate. Mr. Bennett advised the Board that the role of alternate delegate to the Land of Sky Board of Delegates is vacant with the retirement of former town manager Darhyl Boone. The alternate represents the Town in the event that the primary delegate, Mayor Chandler in the case of Mars Hill, is absent or otherwise unable to attend these meetings. This position needs to be filled by some Town official, and Mr. Bennett is willing to fill that role on behalf of the Town if it is the pleasure of the Board.

Upon hearing from Mr. Bennett, Mayor Chandler called for a motion. Alderman Jolley made a motion to approve the resolution presented by management entitled "Resolution Authorizing Appointment of Alternate Delegate to Land of Sky Regional Council of Governments Board of Delegates," thereby appointing Mars Hill Town Manager Nathan R. Bennett, as the alternate delegate to the Land of Sky

Regional Council Board of Delegates. Alderman Honeycutt seconded the motion. Upon a call for a vote on the motion by the Mayor, the motion was approved unanimously. (Attachment G)

### **Project Update**

Mr. Bennett advise the Board that the I-26/Calvin Edney pump station and sewer line installation project continues on schedule. Substantial completion date is set for May 15, 2019 and the final project completion date is set for June 14, 2019. At the last progress meeting it was announced that the contractor plans to begin work on the basins at the wastewater treatment plant next week. Mr. Bennett advise that the Smith Farm Park and the grant application and development of the supporting documentation for the N.C. Parks and Recreation Trust Fund (PARTF) grant process has taken a considerable amount of time and resources. Now that the bulk of that work is complete, and the application submitted prior to the May 1<sup>st</sup> deadline, he expects to be able to move on to other activities.

### General Update

Mr. Bennett advised that he is beginning the budgeting process and will be working with department heads and others to start collecting the necessary data to propose the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Budget Plan. Mr. Bennett also advised the Board that the Town was not accepted into the Downtown Strong program as discussed last month. According to the Department of Commerce, there were more applications received than expected and Mars Hill was placed on a waiting list for possible work in the summer.

### **Road Closure Ordinance**

Mr. Bennett advised the Board that he received a request this afternoon from Chief of Police Michael Garrison for the temporary closure of Cascade Street in the vicinity of Moore Auditorium for Mars Hill University graduation ceremonies on May 11, 2019 from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Chief Garrison provided an ordinance for approval by the Board as part of the requirements of N.C. Department of Transportation to authorize such temporary closure of state roadways. Upon review and discussion of the Ordinance as presented by Chief Garrison, Mayor Chandler called for a motion. Alderman Jolley made a motion to approve the ordinance presented by management entitled "An Ordinance Declaring a Road Closure for Mars Hill University's Graduation Ceremony." Alderman Honeycutt seconded the motion. Upon a call for a vote on the motion by the Mayor, the motion was approved unanimously. (Attachment H)

### **Adjourn**

There being no further business before the Board, Mayor Chandler called for a motion to adjourn. Alderman Zink made a motion to adjourn, Alderman Jolley seconded the motion. Upon a call for a vote on the motion by the Mayor, the motion to adjourn was unanimously approved.

ORDINANCE # 2019-04-01

### AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A ROAD CLOSURE FOR MARS HILL UNIVERSITY'S GRADUATION CEREMONY:
