Being no Agenda Modification, a motion was made by Bob Zink, second by Nick Honeycutt to approve the Agenda as presented. Unanimous approval.


There was discussion concerning rules for the Greenway. It was determined that bicycles would be allowed. Dogs will be allowed if on a six foot leash.
