Nathan Waldrup Promoted To Fire Chief

The Town of Mars Hill is pleased to announce the promotion of Nathan Waldrup to the position of Fire Chief of the Mars Hill Fire Department. Chief Waldrup previously served as deputy fire chief of the department since 2015.

Chief Waldrup is a life-long resident of Mars Hill and has served in the fire service most of his life. Since beginning his service with the Mars Hill Fire Department in 1994 as a volunteer, Chief Waldrup has worked in every capacity



in the department from firefighter to captain and assistant chief. In 2001, he had the opportunity for fire service to become his career when he was hired by Ebbs Chapel Fire Department. He served Ebbs Chapel as captain and was promoted to deputy chief where he served until returning to Mars Hill Fire as full-time deputy chief.

The fire chief is responsible for all fire response activities, fire inspections, pre-incident planning and public safety programming. Chief Waldrup will coordinate the activities of some 30 volunteer firefighters and first responders and a full-time staff of five personnel.

In making this appointment, the Town recognizes the valuable experience, training and education Chief Waldrup has achieved throughout his career in public safety. In addition to his extensive experience, Chief Waldrup holds numerous certifications in fire and rescue operations from the N.C. Fire & Rescue Commission, N.C. Emergency Management, N.C. Office of Emergency Medical Services, and FEMA.

Chief Waldrup is a very proud husband and father to his children and enjoys the outdoors and cooking. We are pleased to welcome him to this new position and look forward to continuing superior service from the Mars Hill Fire Department.

Monthly Water Billing

Reminder – The Town of Mars Hill has transitioned to a monthly billing cycle for water and sewer services. This change was effective July 1, 2019 and customers received a notice in their July statements.

Please be aware that the monthly bill will be sent the last week of each month and will be due on the 15th day of the following month. *For example*, the bill you just received in September will be due on October 15th and will be considered delinquent on October 16th with late penalties added at that time.
