#### **TOWN, HOFFMAN FOUNDATION &** FRIENDS OF BAILEY MOUNTAIN WORKING TO PRESERVE FOREST STREET FARM

The Town of Mars Hill has partnered with the Richard L. Hoffman Foundation and the Friends of Bailey Mountain to preserve the 75-acre West Farm located on Forest Street adjacent to the Town-owned Bailey Mountain Park and Preserve. The full purchase price is approximately \$1.6 million. This vast undertaking by the Town to secure funding to complete this property purchase will conserve and protect one of the most beautiful properties in Town. The property will be added to the existing Bailey Mountain property. Town officials have committed local funds for the project and are aggressively seeking grant funding from federal, state, and other sources to complete this important effort. The Hoffman Foundation will work on behalf of the Town to lead the private-sector fundraising effort with the goal of raising \$100,000 in tax-deductible donations from private sources to complete the purchase by the end of 2026. #### POOL TO OPEN MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND

The Town Recreation Pool is expected to open Saturday, May 24th and operate through early August as available staffing will allow. Tentative operation hours are Monday-Saturday, noon until 5:00 p.m., and Sunday, 1:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. Seasonal pool passes and pool parties are available by contacting Town Hall. #### REGISTER FOR CODERED ALERTS!

**CODERED ALERTS** is a citizen notification system to receive alerts and updates during emergency and special events affecting the Town of Mars Hill. The Town uses CODERED to relay information such as emergency conditions, road detours. water line breaks, weather-related directives, closures, or other service-related and event information through phone calls, text messages, emails, and social media.

Participation in this alert notification system is voluntary and registration must be initiated by the citizen or business owner. Registration can be completed online at the website: https://accountportal.onsolve.net/marshillalerts OR from your smartphone by texting ALERTMARSHILL to 24639. If you do not have internet access, please visit Town Hall at 280 North Main Street, or call (828) 689-2301 for assistance by town staff to complete the registration process.

#### FOG: WHAT IS IT AND HOW YOU CAN HELP?

Residual fats, used cooking oils (UCO), and grease are collectively referred to as FOG.



- ✓ Put oil and grease in collection containers
- ✓ Remove oil and grease from kitchen utensils, equipment and food preparation areas with scrapers/towels/brooms
- ✓ Keep grease out of wash water
- ✓ Place food scraps in collection containers



- O Pour oil and grease down drains
- Wash fryers/griddles, pots/pans and plates with water until oil and grease are removed
- O Use hot water to rinse grease off surfaces
- O Put food scraps down drains
