RECYCLING REMINDERS

Mixed Garbage: All kinds of garbage except newspaper, cardboard and yard waste.

Tree Limbs: Please stack tree limbs in neat bundles near street (no need to tie). DO NOT mix any metals, vines or leaves

with limbs..

Cardboard: Please flatten boxes, (saves truck space, pickup time and your tax dollars).

Paper waste: Books, magazines, junk mail, cereal boxes, with the exception of shredded paper.

Plastic: Plastics #1-#7. Rinse.

Glass: Food jars & beverage bottles. Rinse and remove lids. No mirrors or window glass.

Aluminum & These items may be mixed. Please rinse and flatten the cans.

Steel Cans: Labels do not need to be removed.

*****Recyclable items can now be mixed and placed into one container for pick up*****

Friday Yard Waste Leaves, Grass clippings, vines, etc. These items must be bagged. (No metal and/or wires.)

Please place recycle goods at curb every week, if possible.
