## **RECYCLING REMINDERS**

**Mixed Garbage:** All kinds of garbage except newspaper, cardboard and yard waste.

- **Tree Limbs:** Please stack tree limbs in neat bundles near street (no need to tie). DO NOT mix any metals, vines or leaves with limbs..
- **Cardboard:** Please flatten boxes, (saves truck space, pickup time and your tax dollars).
- Paper waste: Books, magazines, junk mail, cereal boxes, with the exception of shredded paper.
- **Plastic:** Plastics #1-#7. Rinse.
- Glass: Food jars & beverage bottles. Rinse and remove lids. No mirrors or window glass.
- **Aluminum &** These items may be mixed. Please rinse and flatten the cans. **Steel Cans:** Labels do not need to be removed.



\*\*\*\*\*Recyclable items can now be mixed and placed into one container for pick up\*\*\*\*\*

**Friday Yard Waste** Leaves, Grass clippings, vines, etc. These items must be bagged. (No metal and/or wires.)

Please place recycle goods at curb every week, if possible.
