RECYCLING REMINDERS

Mixed Garbage: All kinds of garbage except newspaper, cardboard and yard waste.

Tree Limbs: Please stack tree limbs in neat bundles near street (no need to tie). DO NOT mix any metals, vines or leaves with limbs..

Newspapers: Bundle and tie, or fold and stack inside paper bags.

Cardboard: Please flatten boxes, (saves truck space, pickup time and your tax dollars).

Paper waste: Books, magazines, junk mail, cereal boxes, with the exception of shredded paper.

Glass: Food jars & beverage bottles. Rinse and remove lids. No mirrors or window glass.

Aluminum & These items may be mixed. Please rinse and flatten the cans.

Steel Cans: Labels do not need to be removed.

Friday Yard Waste: Leaves, Grass clippings, vines, etc. These items must be bagged. (No metal and/or wires.)

REMINDER

Please place recycle goods at curb every week, if possible.

This will help keep our pickup more consistent,
save man hours and trips for disposal
which means savings for everyone.

Please do not mix other items with paper waste.
